Mustangs Boys Golf finish 12th at Union County

MORGANTOWN – Muhlenberg County's Heath Embry carded an 81 to finish in a tie for 13th at the Union County Invitational held Thurs-

day (July 28) at Breckinridge Golf Course.

The Mustangs had a total of 386 to finish in 12th place in the team competition. Round-

ing out the scoring for MCHS were Dawson Hambrick (98), Josh Randall (99) and Cameron Hambrick (108). The Mustangs' fifth scorer

was Cy Tudor (118).

Trigg County's Hunter Reynolds was the medalist with a score of 74. Henderson County's Josh Thompson

was runner-up with 75.

Caldwell County's Colin Whittington (75), Daviess County's Dawson Lamb (77) and McCracken County's Tyler

Dew (77) rounded out the top five.

Henderson County won the team title with a 318. Trigg County was the runner-up with 319.

Randall's 83 paces MCHS at Hoptown

HOPKINSVILLE – Muhlenberg County's Josh Randall shot an 83 on Monday (Aug. 1) to lead the Mustangs at the Hopkinsville Tigers Invitational held at the Hopkinsville Golf & Country Club.

Heath Embry carded an 86 for MC with Luke Hardin (91) and Cameron Hambrick (105) rounding out the scoring. Dawson Hambrick (113)

was the team's fifth scorer.

The Mustangs shot a 365 overall which was good for 13th place.

McCracken County won the team title with McCracken County's Camryn Beatty topping Daviess County's Grant Boughton in a playoff to claim medalist honors. Both golfers finished regulation place with a score of 70.

Coombs finishes third at Kentucky Open

LOUISVILLE - Former Muhlenberg County High School standout Connor Coombs finished with a three-day total of 212 to finish third in the amateur division of the 103rd Kentucky Open Championship crown held July 26-28 at Persimmon Ridge Golf Club in Louisville.

A total of 96 amateurs and 60 professionals participated in the prestigious event. Coombs, who wrapped his impressive collegiate career at Murray

State last Spring, finished with scores of 72-68-72 (212). His total also tied for fifth overall among the entire field.

Murray State Hall of Famer Patrick Newcomb won the 2022 Kentucky Open when he carded a final round 4-under-par 68. The victory is Newcomb's seventh as a professional and it puts him into a rare class of 14 golfers who have won the Kentucky Open and the Kentucky State Amateur Championship. When he was a student-athlete with the Racers, Newcomb scored victories at the State Am in 2011 and 2012.

Newcomb's score line included rounds of 67-71-68=206 as he won the event by five shots over Kyle Wilshire at 211.

Matthew Troutman was the low amateur in the tournament with a line of 70-70-69=209.

Heath Embry led the Mustangs' scoring with an 81 followed by Josh Randall (96), Dawson Hambrick (98) and Cameron Hambrick (111). MC's fifth scorer was Cy Tudor (112). Marshall County won the team title with a 292. Ohio County placed second (306).

MADISONVILLE – Heath Embry fired a 78 on Saturday (July 30) to lead the Mustangs at the Madisonville-North Hopkins Invitational at Lakeshore Country Club.

The Mustangs finished with a 401 overall and placed 18th in the team competition. Marshall County won the event with a score of 295. The Marshals' Trey Wall shot a 1-under 71 to earn medalist honors.

**THE SUPERVISORS OF MUHLENBERG COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT
SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2021 - JUNE 30, 2022**

Conservation districts are a valuable resource to landowners who face the challenges posed by natural resource use & management. The Muhlenberg County Conservation District was organized on July 16, 1946. The district is a subdivision of state government, and is governed by a 7 member board of supervisors. The mission of the conservation district is to provide leadership in conservation, and to administer programs to help land users conserve; improve; and sustain natural resources and the environment.

The District relies on partnerships with many organizations and agencies to accomplish its goals. These organizations/agencies include the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), the Farm Service Agency (FSA), the Muhlenberg County University of Kentucky Extension Service, the Kentucky Division of Conservation, the Pennyriple Resource Conservation and Development Council (RC&D), the Muhlenberg County Fiscal Court, City of Greenville and City of Central City.

Priorities for the District include:

- Working with watershed conservancy districts to promote maintenance of structures and channels.
- Sponsorship of students to attend 4H Camp, Forestry Camp and Conservation Camp.
- Sponsorship of Muhlenberg County High School Soil Judging Team.
- Annual Take a Kid Fishing Event 2nd Saturday in June.
- Annual Art & Writing Contest every fall.
- Annual Tree Day in April - 1000 free tree seedlings given away.
- Sponsorship of the KACD Auxiliary Scholarship Program.
- Farm Bill Legislation - Programs such as Cropland Reserve Program (CRP), Environmental Quality Incentive Program (EQIP), State Cost Share (SCS), Agriculture Water Quality Program (AWQ) and conservation planning.
- Other items as detailed in the District’s Annual Plan of Work.

During the 2022 fiscal year, Muhlenberg County NRCS focused primarily on disaster cleanup. We took 16 applications for clean up of wooded areas in and around Bremen. Of those 16 applications, 3 cancelled and 13 were approved bringing in a total of \$197,508.67. In addition to disaster cleanup efforts, NRCS had 2 additional applications approved for practices related to pasture and livestock. Those applications brought in an additional amount of \$48,580.

Kentucky State Cost Share Program

During the 2022 fiscal year, Muhlenberg County Conservation District had 1 Kentucky State Cost Share application approved in the amount of \$12,383.75. The Kentucky State Cost Share Program offers landowners an opportunity to apply for cost share assistance to implement best management conservation practices on their land to protect soil and water resources. The cost share rate is 75% of actual cost up to \$20,000 per applicant per year. **Application cut-off date October 31, 2022.**

Due to COVID-19, we were unable to hold our annual awards banquet in March. However, our local elementary schools continued their participation in the Annual Jim Claypool Conservation Art Contest. The following students received awards for their participation.

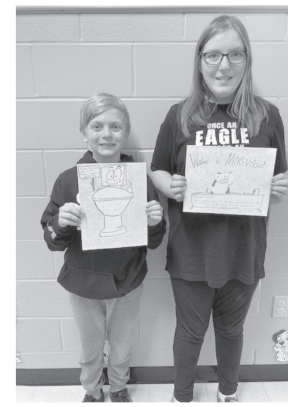

Recycling equipment and services were provided for this program through the Environmental Grant Program with Kentucky Division of Conservation.





Q: I've heard some things about foster care and adoption, and I'm curious -- but hesitant because our family is already so busy. Somebody told me that your organization strongly supports foster adoption. Why do you think we should get involved?

Jim: This is an issue close to my heart because I was an orphan myself in elementary school -- both of my parents died by the time I was 12. I know what it feels like to drift through life without the anchor of a parent's love. So, I empathize with the 140 million children worldwide who just want to call someone "Mom" and "Dad."

When we hear the

word "orphan," many of us envision poor kids in developing nations' slums. That's certainly a serious global issue that deserves much more attention. But there are over 120,000 adoption-eligible children in the United States' foster care system. They dream of real homes filled with love and laughter; they crave acceptance and a place to belong. That's why Focus on the Family established the "Wait No More" campaign.

I believe that American culture's "me first" attitude has undermined our God-given sense of benevolence. We're presented with countless opportunities to entertain ourselves with media,

sports, hobbies and possessions. Those things aren't inherently wrong. But when we pursue them so much that we fail to love and care about those among us who are truly hurting, we definitely need to rethink our priorities.

Sure, adoption isn't for every family. But my guess is that many couples could find room in their hearts for a child who doesn't have a place to call home. And there are many ways that families who don't adopt can help those who do. Q: My husband and I have been married

nearly 10 years. But we have a lot of relational problems. I think we're both wondering if we should just bag it and go our separate ways. Why would our marriage even be worth trying to save?

Dr. Greg Smalley, Vice President, Marriage & Family Formation: My heart goes out to you. I'm sure what you're facing is difficult and discouraging. But I believe your marriage is worth fighting for, for many reasons.

First -- if you have children, their welfare should be one of your most important considerations. Some people claim that kids are relieved when their parents divorce because that means the arguments stop. But that's really not true. In fact, studies show that divorce is one

of the biggest fears for children. Decades later, children whose parents divorced generally still remember the loneliness and fear caused by the breakup.

Research also shows that divorced couples aren't significantly happier once their marriage ends. In fact, most wish they'd worked harder to save their marriage.

But what happens if you put in the work to repair and strengthen your marriage? Again, the research emphasizes that in most cases each spouse experiences greater physical, mental and emotional health, and their relationship is stronger and happier.

So, here's my advice: You don't have to choose between staying in an unhappy marriage or divorcing and being

just as miserable. Your marriage can be restored if you're both willing to try. Yes, it'll take work. But a healthy, thriving relationship is worth the effort. I'd even say it's priceless.

No, it's not. Debt consolidation companies try to position themselves that way, but they don't even come close to ad-

ressing or solving the real problem.

Here's the big reason debt consolidation isn't a good idea. It makes you feel like you truly did something to change your whole financial outlook when you didn't. When you move things around, or suddenly have a lower payment each month, you end up thinking you're making real progress. The thing is you didn't do anything to address the actual problem—which is you.

I meet people and talk to folks on my radio show all the time who don't quite grasp this. They'll tell me they paid off all their debt by using a debt consolidation company or taking out

a second mortgage on their homes. Well, the truth is they're not debt-free. They didn't do anything but shuffle the same old debt around.

Personal finance is 80% behavior, Erikah. When it comes to getting out of debt, staying out of debt and getting your finances into shape, you have to change your habits and behaviors with money. Interest rates aren't the problem, and the number of payments you're facing aren't the problem. The problem is the person you see in the mirror every morning.

Until you change that person, and start living on a strict, written monthly budget and decide to kick debt out of

your life once and for all, you'll never make any real progress toward gaining control of your money!

Yummasetti

2 lb hamburger
1/2 cup chopped onion
2 teas salt
1/2 teas black pepper
6 oz macaroni
3 potatoes, cubed
1 cup peas
1 can cream of mushroom soup*
1/2 can cream of chicken soup
1 1/2 cup milk
2 cups toasted bread crumbs
1 cup shredded cheese of your choice

Fry all together until burger is no longer pink, drain. Place in a roaster or cake pan. Cook macaroni and potatoes until tender (in 2 separate pots). Layer on top of burger mixture. Mix soup and milk together and pour over all. Cover and bake at 350 for an hour. Spread bread crumbs on top, if you like, press down gently with a spoon, then top with cheese.

* I personally do not use boughten soups. This can be replaced with a gravy, homemade soup, or ranch, then use only half of milk.

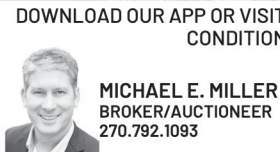
